



Why Multidimensional Poverty?

Efficiency: Reduction in \$1/day poverty is <u>not</u> correlated with reductions in non-monetary MDGs



Build a deprivation score for each person


Stephanie faces multiple deprivations at present

3 Dimensions

Identify who is poor

Example: A person is multidimensionally poor if they are deprived in 33% of the dimensions.



Compute the MPI (Alkire-Foster)

The MPI is the product of two components:

Formula: $MPI = H \times A$

- 1) *Incidence* ~ the percentage of people who are poor, *H*.
- 2) Intensity \sim the average percentage of dimensions in which poor people are deprived A.




